1. Theme and policy roadmap PRIORITIES IN NEW GEOPOLITICAL AND MARKET REALITIES

Urgency to transform Europe's energy system impacted by price volatility and energy insecurity across the world:

- end the EU's dependence on Russian fossil fuels, used as an economic and political weapon
- accelerate our clean energy transition
- tackle the climate crisis

- A roadmap to reduce the dependence on Russian fossil fuels and fast forward the energy transition
- Based on 3 pillars:
- Energy saving and energy efficiency
- Massive acceleration of investment in renewables
- Diversification of our energy supplies

- EU Green Deal Packages: negotiations with the European Parliament and the Council on several acts related to energy: energy performance of buildings, energy efficiency, renewable energy sources, decarbonised gas markets and renewable hydrogen, methane, etc.
- National Energy and Climate Plans and Recovery and Resilience Plans





1. Theme and policy roadmap NEW ACTS FORESEEN IN 2023

- Optimisation of the EU electricity market Q1 2023
- Other acts on: cyber security of energy systems, carbon capture utilisation and storage, review of the Governance of the Energy Union and Climate Action, new ecodesign and energy labelling for specific product groups, etc.
- And, 2023 is the European Year of Skills

3. Call for policy sessions and Energy Fair GENERAL INFORMATION

- Taking place over 3 days (20 22 June 2023)
- Centralised conference logistics and facilities
- Autonomous organisation and decentralised promotion
- Feedback and reporting
- Sessions of 90 minutes
- Stands onsite





3. Call for policy sessions and Energy Fair WHO CAN APPLY

- Representatives of EU institutions, including interinstitutional bodies
- Organisations and associations which fulfil the following criteria:
 - working as multipliers using a widespread network of contacts across Europe
 - contributing to the development and implementation of sustainable energy policy.

Professional event organisers or businesses aiming to promote specific products or services **are not eligible**. Sessions and stands should be free of commercial interest.





3. Call for policy sessions and Energy Fair PREPARING YOUR APPLICATION Policy sessions

- Find your partnering organisations to submit a joint application (no more than 2 proposals per organisation)
- Have a clear objective in mind
- Present a gender balanced panel (no more than 6 speakers per session)
- Be interactive (allocate sufficient time to create an interaction between your audience and the speakers)
- Choose the thematic tags that best describe your session + type of session









3. Call for policy sessions and Energy Fair PREPARING YOUR APPLICATION

Policy sessions: thematic tags

- ✓ Skills for the clean energy transition (e.g. education, training, reskilling, skills for all)
- ✓ Energy efficiency (e.g. energy performance of buildings, products, industry transport)
- ✓ Renewables (e.g. solar strategy, permitting processes for renewable energy, local energy cooperatives)
- ✓ Ensuring affordability and inclusion in the clean energy transition (e.g.: citizens and consumer empowerment, energy poverty, prosumers)
- ✓ **Decarbonisation policies and international cooperation** (e.g. Green Deal measures, COP28, SECAPS, Emissions Trading System)

Policy sessions: evaluation criteria

- Concept and focus
- Relevance of the topic (content)
- Quality of the agenda

Thursday, 2 March 2023 | deadline for Energy Fair applications
March 2023 | evaluation process

End of March 2023 | results communicated and coordination meeting for policy session organisers

14 April 2023 | deadline to submit content by sessions organisers and stand holders

Mid-April 2023 | registrations open

4. Call for Awards INNOVATION AWARD – WHO CAN APPLY

- Ongoing or concluded EU-funded projects (after 31 December 2021)
- Activities carried out in at least one country located in the EU or the EEA





4. Call for Awards LOCAL ENERGY ACTION AWARD – WHO CAN APPLY

- Associations, organisations, groups of people
- Activities carried out in at least one country located in the EU or the EEA

4. Call for Awards WOMAN IN ENERGY AWARD – WHO CAN APPLY

- Women
- The application should refer to an individual (not groups)
- Can be nominated by another person
- Nominees should be actively carrying activities in the field of sustainable energy and be resident in one country located in the EU or the EEA





4. Call for Awards EVALUATION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

- Concept
- Implementation
- Impact
- Finalists are chosen by a Technical Advisory Committee and a High Level Jury from a shortlist of the year's most successful projects and actions for clean, secure and efficient energy.
- Winners will be awarded in the three categories via an online public vote


